COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA

Direct employment statewide in life sciences companies is 112,000 with \$11 billion in wages.

- 2,841 life sciences business establishments.
- **\$48.8 billion** annual economic impact.
- 727 research and development-based companies formed since 2008.
- **\$1.778** billion in venture capital funding ranked #5 in the U.S.
- **\$1.67 billion NIH funding** for Pennsylvania research projects

Pennsylvania has **2** of the top **5** research institutions as measured by NIH funding. The University of Pennsylvania is #4 and the University of Pittsburgh is #5.

Ranked *5th nationally for clinical trials.* More than 1,170 trials in 2017 with \$401 million in investment and a \$1 billion economic impact.

4,317 patents from 2011-2016. Ranked #5 in the nation.

IMPORTANT PROGRAMS AND TAX CREDITS FOR THE LIFE SCIENCES INDUSTRY

Keystone Opportunity Zone - State and local tax-sheltered business zones (Philadelphia Navy Yard)

Keystone Innovation Zone - Provides tax credits for companies in targeted zones

Research and Development Tax Credit - Tax credit for increase spending on R&D (\$55 million / year)

Pennsylvania First Program - Comprehensive funding tool to facilitate increased investment and job creation within the Commonwealth.

Redevelopment Assistance Capital Program - Commonwealth grant program. \$125 million available annually through a competitive application process.

Innovate in Pennsylvania - Providing funding to life sciences-related organizations. \$80 million in new funding by 2015.
